

Number of States and Countries our Student-Athletes Represent





JACKRABBIT CLUB LEVEL UP

All renewing Jackrabbit Club members will have the opportunity to Level Up their giving. Donors who increase their giving at least one benefit level higher than previous years are eligible to receive the following two gifts. The 2025 gifts are the following:

- 1. Pre-Game Football Experience for two (2) during one (1) 2025 home football game
- 2. Exclusive Jackrabbit Club flag

Extra Benefit: Anyone who joins the Level Up initiative will be entered into a drawing for a chance to win two (2) 2026 Summit League Basketball All Session passes.















PRIORITY POINTS SYSTEM

2 points per \$100 donated to the Jackrabbit Club

1 point per \$100 donated to any other athletics fund

(e.g. endowments, capital projects, excellence funds)

1 point per \$100 worth of value for items donated to the Jackrabbit Athletic Scholarship Auction

3 points per consecutive year of Jackrabbit Club Membership

1 point per year, for which you hold season tickets

3 points per year, for which you make your donation by the May 27th renewal deadline

25 points Jackrabbit Club membership level upgrade

20 points for former student-athletes (one-time)⁵

15 points for non-student-athlete alumni (one-time)⁵

5 points for faculty/staff donors (one-time)⁵

PRIORITY POINTS FOR FIRST BANK & TRUST ARENA

50 bonus for a signed pledge of \$10,000 or more to facility **points**

100 bonus for those that made a \$10,000+ gift to multiple facilities **points**

2 points for every \$100 (similar to JRC), cash in hand

(In addition to the bonus points for those that make a pledge of \$10,000+)

1 Point for every \$100, Suite Priority Points

(5-10 year contracts, this will also include Dana J. Dykhouse Stadium Suites)

The SDSU Athletics priority points system takes into account longevity in season ticket purchases, letterwinner/alumni status, and annual/cumulative athletics contributions and is set up to reward consistency in investment in SDSU student-athletes. Priority points are used for determining selection time in an allocation year, for away game tickets, and for post-season tickets (in conjunction with Jackrabbit Club membership level) and other athletics considerations.

Jackrabbit Club membership year ends May 31. Contributions received by May 31 qualify for Jackrabbit Club annual membership and benefits beginning June 1.

'Jackrabbit Club members must be season ticket holders to receive a parking pass. The number of passes listed at each membership level is the maximum number of passes allowable upon request.

²Complimentary general admission to all home SDSU sporting events (excludes FB, MBB, WBB and postseason events).

³Jackrabbit Club hospitality for football and basketball games include complimentary food and beverage options.

Basketball hospitality dates will be determined and communicated to members near the start of the basketball season.



Football at DANA J. DYKHOUSE STADIUM






One Day for STATE from 2017 to 2024

Jacked NIL

An NIL activity occurs when a studentathlete is compensated for the use of his or her name, image and/or likeness. Activities range from sponsored social media posts and operating camps to autograph appearances and apparel sales.

Via Jacked NIL, Jackrabbit supporters can directly pitch student-athletes an NIL deal in just a few clicks at gojacks.co/jackednil. After receiving a notification of a deal on the marketplace, athletes can accept, complete, and receive payment for the opportunity on Opendorse's secure platform. Once a deal is completed, the activity is automatically disclosed for compliance purposes and tax documentation is generated.


Additionally, corporate partners can add NIL deals into current sponsorship packages by contacting Jackrabbit Sports Properties (Learfield).
